



Postdoctoral Fellowship at Cira Center for Behavioral Health

Cira Center for Behavioral Health (CCBH) is a growing group practice located in Chicago's Loop looking to hire a full time Clinical Psychology Postdoctoral Fellow.

Clinical Work:

- Primary responsibilities will be in conducting intake assessments and providing individual, couple, family, and group psychotherapy with the age and gender spectrum (around 25 clients/week). Must be able to treat or open to treating (with supervision) individuals, children, adolescents, families, and couples.
- Sessions are currently being conducted in person from our Loop office or via Telehealth remotely. We expect to return to a hybrid (in-person and virtual) model as soon as it is safe to do so
- An interest, experience, and/or basic knowledge about working with trauma survivors.
- Graduated with a doctorate in psychology (Ph.D. or Psy.D.).
- Willing to work at least 3 evenings OR 2 evenings and a Saturday or Sunday.
- Applicants who have experience in women's issues/health and/or trauma and/or are EMDR trained will be given special consideration.

Values Work:

- White therapists are required to engage in personal and internal antiracism work by reading books, podcasts, etc. and external antiracism work, including training courses, both in- and out-of-house, and in team discussions.
- Participate in at least one of our antiracist quarterly initiatives. Recent initiatives have focused on voter suppression and engagement, supporting BIPOC-owned business during COVID, Black maternal health, and Asian Americans and mental health.
- Therapists of color will have the option to meet regularly with the other therapists of color on the team, but these meetings are optional.

Team Work:

- Identifies as a Team Player and Problem Solver.
- Enjoys Supervision, Consultation and Collaboration.
- Is active on Slack, our internal communications platform, reading and responding to Teammates in a timely manner (for the most part, this replaces most email obligations).
- Steps up for volunteer events/positions as necessary (Holiday Giving Campaign, Diversity Presentations, etc).
- Excited to get to know their Teammates and spend time together at quarterly work social events.

Benefits:

- Fantastic location on Michigan Avenue across from Millennium Park. The Loop office is housed in an impeccable building with tons of great amenities.
- You will be an employee of CCBH, which includes benefits like PTO, major medical Blue Cross Blue Shield insurance, 401K contributions, and compensation towards continuing education training.
- All caseload building, scheduling, and billing are taken care of for you.
- All marketing is taken care of, which includes but is not limited to, a Psychology Today profile, business cards, brochures, postcards, and all other marketing material.
- A paper-free existence! Everything we do is electronic, and documentation is very minimal.
- Weekly individual supervision.
- Weekly meetings with the Team.
- Opportunity to supervise a graduate student.
- A highly collaborative, relational, and fun working environment.
- Possibility for a full-time position upon completion of the fellowship.

Postdoc Fellowship Experience at CCBH

- Full-time position of 40 hours a week over 12 months.
- Thursdays are mandatory, as are 3 evenings or 2 evenings and a Saturday however you will have a lot of schedule autonomy
- Billing minimum of 23/week, so you can expect to be seeing 25+/week
- Currently, sessions are being conducted virtually from home however you do have the option to see clients in-person or virtually at our Loop location
- 1 hour of individual supervision per week by a licensed clinical psychologist
- 1 hour of supplemental supervision per week by a licensed therapist
- 1 hour of Team meetings per week that include: clinical trainings, antiracist/antioppression work, group consultation, team building activities, affinity group spaces, etc.
- 1-1.5 hours of CEUs + certificates per month will be provided to you through in-house trainings
- Opportunity to supervise a graduate student
- Engage in 1 antiracist/antioppression Quarterly Initiative with a committee of staff members
- Salary is \$52,000, which includes 10 PTO days and 10 major holidays paid
